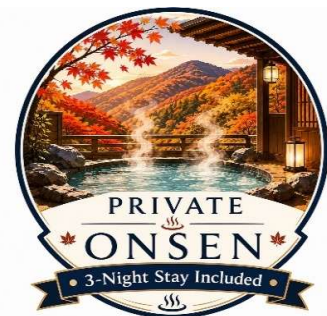

2. You must be in good health and able to walk long distances (at least 1-3 miles per day) during the tour. **Please note that our tour guide is unable to provide wheelchair assistance during this tour.*
3. You must fully read and understand the tour itinerary before participating in this tour.
4. You must be able to use a smartphone and communicate with our tour guide in Japan during the tour.
5. Daily tour schedules are subject to change at any time due to weather conditions, transportation schedules, or unforeseen circumstances.
6. Playing smartphone games such as "Pokémon Go" is not allowed during the tour.
7. It is illegal to carry any knife (over 2.7 inch) with you in Japan.
8. Due to limited storage space on public transportation systems, it is recommended to carry 1 carry-on and/or 1 small bag/backpack per person.
9. One person is recommended to bring 1 large- or medium-size suitcase and 1 foldable bag (duffle bag) in addition to a small carry-on or backpack.
10. Travel insurance is highly recommended to purchase for your protection.
11. A list of your hotels in Japan will be provided to you with a final tour itinerary approximately 1 month before the tour departure date. Japanese hotel rooms are generally smaller than ones in the US. Your hotels will be budget/economy-class/business-type (non-smoking twin or 2-bed room for a double occupancy and single or 1-bed room for a single occupancy).
12. Credit cards are widely accepted to make your payments in Japan. However, it is recommended to exchange and carry some amount of cash (Japanese Yen) to be expensed for your own needs. Local small stores, shops (100 yen shops, etc.) and restaurants may not be able to accept credit cards.
